

**37<sup>th</sup> Annual All Ohio Model T Jamboree**  
**Sauder Historical Complex, Archbold, OH**  
**September 4<sup>rd</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup>, 2026**

*NOTE: Registration opens early at noon on Thursday, Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup> to allow full access to the Sauder Village and Sauder complex.*

The **Maumee Valley Model T's** are excited to invite you to the 37<sup>th</sup> Annual All Ohio Model T Jamboree to be held Labor Day weekend 2026. The Host hotel will be at the upscale **Sauder Heritage Inn, 22611 State Route 2, Archbold, Ohio, 43502 (800-590-9755)**, where we have arranged group rates per night ranging from \$131 for a Standard or Executive Room to \$151 for a Deluxe room. Sauder Heritage Inn was named the "Unique Lodging of Ohio Property" of 2025 by the Ohio Hotel & Lodging Association for its innovation, quality and excellence. We also have several Sauder campground sites reserved with full hook up for those who wish to camp. Sauder has plenty of space for trailer parking.

Overflow hotels are available on the north side of Defiance but no room block has been arranged.

This year's Jamboree is very different from those held in the past. This is a "**Destination Tour**" which includes the entire Sauder complex that offers exciting opportunities, especially the **Historic Sauder Village** which fosters "a unique environment that explores the past, engages the senses and inspires wonder." We have negotiated a special deal to allow Jamboree registrants to pay the daily rate only once, but have access Thursday, Friday and Saturday. (The Village closes at 5:00 PM every day.) The village features early community buildings (a farm, a church, shops, etc.), craft demonstrations, an 1834-1908 pioneer settlement, a 1920's Main Street, a train ride, a museum and more. Besides the Village, the Sauder complex includes the Barn Restaurant, the Doughbox Bakery, the Sauder Furniture Store & Outlet, wetlands walkways and a public playground.

**Registration** for the Jamboree will be **Thurs., Sept. 3 from 12:00 noon to 7:00 PM; Fri., Sept. 4 from 7:30 AM to 9:30 AM; and Sat., Sept. 5 from 7:30 AM – 9:30 AM.** The early Thursday registration will provide the opportunity for you to visit the Village that afternoon if you wish. You will need your Jamboree ID to get the special deal at the Village and to have access on Friday and Saturday. To accommodate those who wish to visit the Village on Friday and Saturday, we have developed both long and short tours for those days. Note that the long tours will be all day tours with no time to visit the Village.

**Friday's Tour** was developed by Mike and Betty Wilson and features a scenic drive to Bryan, OH to see Spangler Candy World ("Dum Dums") among other things, then on to Defiance, OH, traveling along the scenic Maumee River.

**Saturday's tour** was developed by Dave Schwab and features the Napoleon Harley Davidson show room, museum, and apparel, then follows the Maumee River to Grand Rapids OH, a historic canal town, featuring charming restored buildings, antique shops, unique gifts and restaurants.

**Sunday's Tour** was developed by Terry and Kim Masserant and features a country drive to the Millbury Classic Car Museum, noted for its immersive, nostalgic atmosphere which includes movie cars (ex., the Batmobile), muscle cars, vintage signs, and themed sets (ex., the Mopar Room). A trip to Grand Rapids, Ohio is included in the long tour.

After the Friday tour, we will host the "Model T Olympics" (3:30 to 5:30 PM) when drivers get to show off their driving skills. Supper is on your own at either the Barn Restaurant on site, or at a restaurant in Archbold. The ice cream social follows at 7:00 PM.

Saturday's Banquet will be at 6:00 PM, followed by the Auction. Please remember to bring items to be auctioned off that night. Proceeds go toward seed money for next year's Jamboree.
