

Keystone Cops Ohio Tour 2015

This year's tour will start in the heart of Ohio Amish Country. Our home base will be at Camp Wanake, which is located on the eastern edge. We will meet on Wednesday at the campground where we will give you the tour itinerary, maps and directions for the tour. We will then travel to nearby Strasburg to eat supper (on your own) at the Manor Restaurant (located down the street from the hotel). If you are planning to stay at a motel, there is plenty of room to park your car trailer at the campground. You can leave your Model T there at night and drive your tow vehicle back and forth if you prefer. The campground does charge a daily fee of \$5 per person for those not camping to comply with their insurance regulations.

Saturday's banquet will take place at the Amish Door (famous for their Amish cooking) in nearby Wilmot in one of their banquet rooms. The menu will consist of Broasted Chicken, Roast Beef, Mashed Potatoes, Dressing, Corn, Gravy, Tossed Salad, Homemade Dinner Rolls, Beverage and a slice of Homemade Pie and will be served Family Style. The cost is \$19 per person, \$11 for children 4-10 and free for children up to age 3. The price includes tax and gratuity and will be on one bill so please include it with your registration.

The routes will take us over a lot of hills and stone roads so make sure you have good bands, emergency brake and a full tank of gas each morning.
