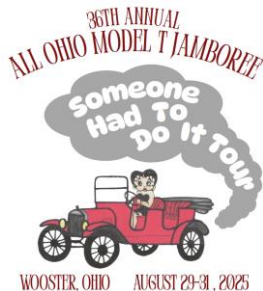

The responsibility for a car's safety and mechanical condition rests with the owner/participant/operator.

### Steering

- \_\_\_\_\_ Steering wheel has *minimal* (less than 2") to *no* play
- Acceptable wear and minimal-to-no play in:
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Radius rod (wish bone) to crankcase
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Ball arm (pitman arm) to steering gear connecting rod (drag link)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Steering gear connecting rod (tie rod) to yoke ball
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Grease in steering gear case and steering gear bracket (also check gear post and pinion gears for wear)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Spindle bolts (king pins)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Spindle connecting rod bolts
- Cotter keys must be installed in the following:
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Radius rod (wish bone) to front axle (2 required)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Steering gear bracket to frame (3 required)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Ball arm (pitman arm) to steering post (1 required)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Steering gear connecting rod (tie rod) to yoke ball (2 required)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Steering gear connecting rod (tie rod)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Steering gear connecting rod (tie rod) to steering gear ball (2 required)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Spindle connecting rod to spindles ( 2 - 1/spindle)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Spindle bolts (king pins) (2 - 1/spindle)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Spindle arms (2 - 1/spindle)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Front spring hangers (shackles) (4 - 2/side)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Front spring to frame (2 or 4 required, depending on year)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Tie rod yoke ball (1 required)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Safety-wire crankcase studs holding radius rod ball cap
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Check for play in steering column (check rivets/taper pins)

### Brakes

- \_\_\_\_\_ Brake pedal (and, reverse pedal) bottom out before reaching floorboards
- \_\_\_\_\_ Both rear wheels lock up under hard braking

### Emergency Brakes

- \_\_\_\_\_ Hand brake sets securely before limit of its travel (check pawl and spring) and both rear wheels lock

NOTE: *The hand brake must be able to hold the car with the engine running and should be able to hold the car on a moderate slope. Auxiliary brakes are highly recommended if the car is equipped with an auxiliary transmission or Ruckstell rear end.*

Cotter keys (or lock washers, if holes not drilled) must be installed on:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Control shaft assembly to frame (4 required)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Brake shoe bolt (2 - 1/side)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Brake rods (4 - 1/end)

### Engine/Power Train

- \_\_\_\_\_ Oil leaks - within acceptable limits
- \_\_\_\_\_ Gasoline leaks - none when parked (in-line shutoff valve recommended)
- Cotter pins must be installed on:
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Carburetor rod (2 - 1/end)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Choke/carburetor adjustment rod (1 at carburetor)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Commutator rod (2 - 1/end)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Crankcase arm to frame (2/ top - 2/side)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Low speed connector (2 - 1/end)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Universal ball cap (2 top bolts - bottom two cap screws safety-wired together)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Fan bolt (on earlier cars)

**Wheels**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Spokes (and felloes on earlier cars) are tight
- \_\_\_\_\_ Front wheel bearings - no play, good condition and greased
- \_\_\_\_\_ All wheels tight and axle/spindle nuts cotter-keyed
- \_\_\_\_\_ Lug nuts tight on demountable rims
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tires checked for wear, weather cracks, rim cuts, correct air pressure, etc.

**Rear Axle**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Rear wheel nuts tight and secured with cotter pins (use long wrench)
- Cotter keys must be installed:
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Rear spring to frame (4 required)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Rear spring hangers (shackles) (4 - 2/side)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Rear spring perches to wheel flanges (backing plates) (2 - 1/side)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ No oil leaks at outer seals
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Check differential gear case oil level

**Other**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Electric lights functional
- \_\_\_\_\_ Brake light (if installed, functional)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Safety glass
- \_\_\_\_\_ Rear view mirror(s) \*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Operational horn/warning device
- \_\_\_\_\_ Fire extinguisher
- \_\_\_\_\_ First aid kit
- \_\_\_\_\_ Registration and Insurance documentation
